

ORDINANCE 346-87

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH AMENDING ORDINANCE 272 PROVIDING AND ESTABLISHING REQUIREMENTS AND PERMITTING THE LOCATION AND DESIGN OF ALL VEHICULAR INGRESS AND EGRESS DRIVEWAYS BETWEEN PRIVATE PROPERTY AND PUBLIC STREETS, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Golden Beach finds that it would be in the best interest for the safety and welfare of the public to set forth requirements for vehicular ingress and egress driveways between private property and public streets, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council recognizes that guidelines for approving and permitting construction and location of driveways should be set forth,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL, TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Vehicular ingress and egress driveways between private property and a public street must meet the requirements of the Building Regulation Board and shall be constructed of materials and in accordance with a driveway permit issued by the Town Building Official.

Section 2. A drawing or plan showing construction standards, specifications and location of the driveway shall be submitted to the Town along with an application and shall be approved by the Building Regulation Board after a public hearing. Each driveway will be reviewed, located and constructed according to safety, traffic conditions and public and governmental requirements necessitated by the conditions existing at each location or according to known future conditions as determined by the Town Building Official and Building Regulation Board.

Section 3. No driveway or accessway shall be permitted at any location which shall constitute or cause a danger to vehicles, or create a
